I. **Approval of Minutes:** A motion was made by Dr. Tack to approve the June 2013 and September 2013 minutes. The motion was seconded by Ms. Hildebrandt and unanimously approved.

II. **Agency Reports:**

a. Commissioner's Update:

On behalf of Dr. Smith, Ms. Veytia reported on the following:

- **Fee Schedule:** A summary of the findings from a study done regarding Environmental Health Permit Fees of other NYS counties was distributed and reviewed (see attached). Topics of discussion were fees for Not-for-Profits, Mass Gatherings, and the permitting of vending machine. This information will be used as a tool when reviewing and considering changes to Ulster County's current permit fee schedule.
- **DOH Relocation:** The relocation team is comprised of a variety of County departments, i.e. Buildings and Grounds, Information Services, Department of Health and Mental Health continue to meet on a weekly basis. Patient Services move is scheduled to take place on October 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. Administration, Environmental and Fiscal is scheduled for relocation by end of December.
- **Community Health Assessment:** The Community Health Assessment continues to be worked on in efforts to meet the State's November 15<sup>th</sup> deadline for submission. A meeting with hospitals and other community agencies to begin strategic mapping for the Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) and the Community Services Plan (CSP) is scheduled for October 10<sup>th</sup>.

• **Mass Gathering:** The Ulster County Mass Gathering protocol continues to be worked on with the County Attorney.

b. **Medical Examiner:** Dr. Heller reported on the activity of the medical examiner's office. A year-to-date summary sheet was distributed and reviewed (see attached.)

c. **Patient Services:** Ms. Veytia reported on the following:

- **New Employee Vaccination Regulation:** NYSDOH has issued a new regulation mandating employees to receive flu vaccination or be required to wear a mask when interacting with a client (see attached.) The regulation applies to all personnel in healthcare and residential facilities and agencies whose job activities are such that they could expose patients or residents to influenza. DOH is in the process of ensuring all appropriate staff are in full compliance with this new regulation.
- **Flu Clinic Schedule:** A copy of the 2013 Flu Clinic Schedule was distributed (see attached.) A discussion occurred regarding the type of vaccine offered at flu clinics. On average, 30-40 individuals are served at these clinics.

d. **Environmental Health Report:** Ms. Mertens reported on the following:

- **J Roccas Food Service Hearing:** Violation fines in the amount of \$5,000 were to be submitted to UCDOH no later than October 2, 2013. To date, no payment has been received. Ms. Mertens will contact UCDOH hearing attorney to discuss next steps.

**Meeting Adjournment:** A motion was made by Dr. Tack to adjourn the meeting, motion was seconded by Ms. Hildebrandt and unanimously approved.

**Next Meeting:** The next meeting is scheduled for December 9, 2013.

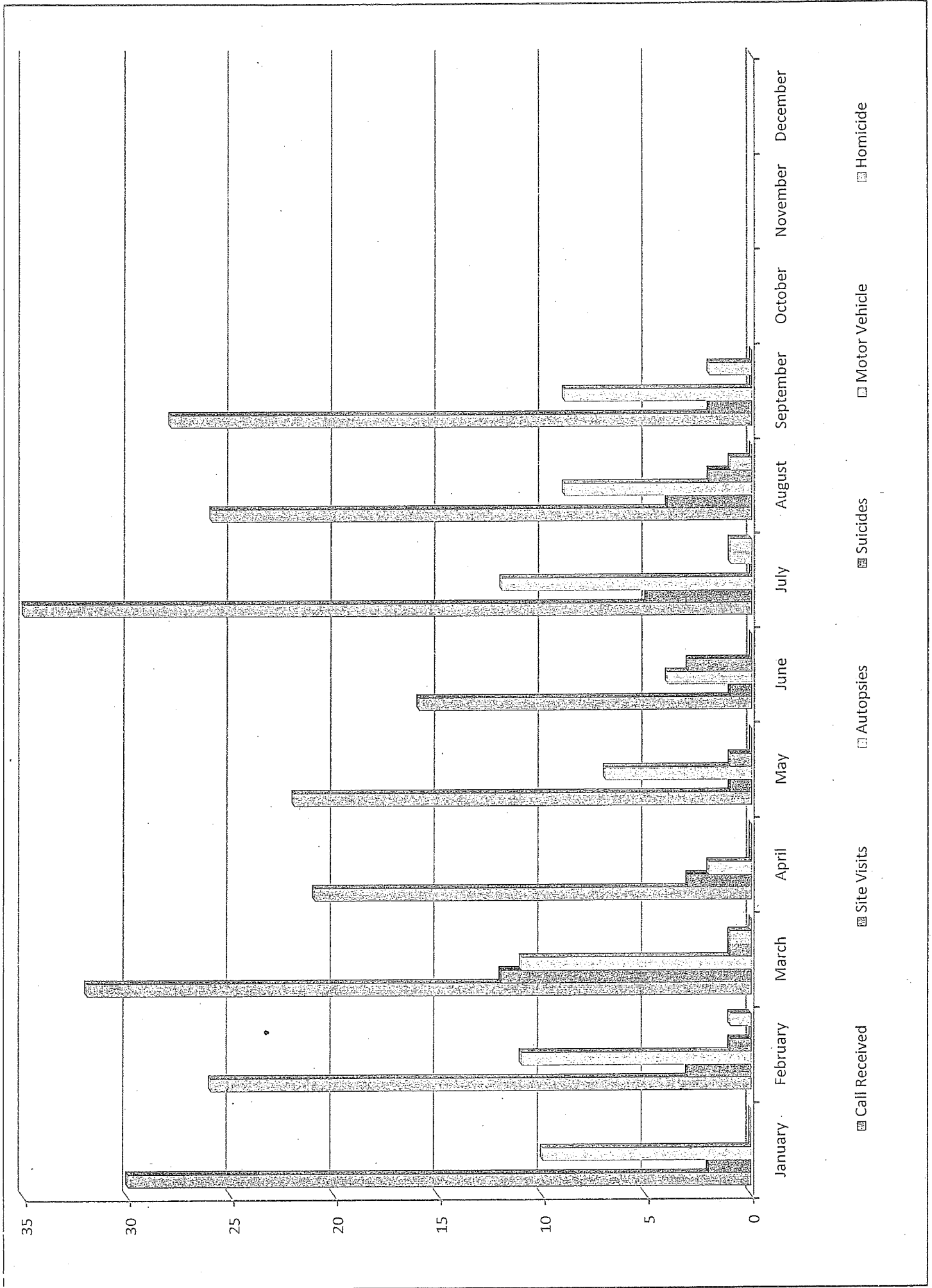
