I. Approval of Minutes: Approval of the September and October minutes was tabled until the December meeting.

II. Agency Reports:

a. Commissioner's Report:

Dr. Smith reported on the following:

- Ebola Preparedness: Working hard to apprise stakeholders on Ebola preparedness protocols. There are 5 airports with flights coming from West Africa. The two (2) that impact NY are JFK and LaGuardia. State workers are manned at the airports assisting in the identification individuals for Ebola monitoring. The State will then notify the appropriate Department of Health of those individuals who have been identified as Isolation and Quarantine cases. hospitals across the State have been identified as Ebola treatment facilities. UCDOH is conducting weekly calls with the hospitals, EMS, and Urgent Care centers to keep abreast of the Commissioner's Orders and any changes or updates. The State is also hosting weekly calls with CDC. There have been several issues that are currently being worked through such as the labs and EMS services not being equipped to handle such cases. Local 911 is participating in triaging potential cases to those facilities that are better equipped to handle the response. Richard Parrish, UC EMS Coordinator is conducting Donning and Doffing trainings. UCDOH Preparedness Program is aggressively working to prepare in the event that an individual is identified for monitoring. Dr. Tack commended Dr. Smith on her response to this effort.
