I. Approval of Minutes: The approval of the March 2014 minutes was tabled until the next meeting due to lack of a quorum.

II. Agency Reports:

a. Commissioner's Report:

Dr. Smith reported on the following:

- Mass Gathering: NYS Article 18 permit has been issued. Continuing to work closely with interdepartmental agencies, NYS Department of Health, Law Enforcement and Community Stakeholders to create the permit conditions for the Article 7 permit.
- Meeting with Health Alliance ER: Dr. Smith met with Dr. Fareed Health Alliance Emergency Room Director and key ER staff on April 2nd regarding UCDOH updated Rabies protocol and forms and to discuss patient follow-up system. Dr. Tack recommended that patient follow-up should be tracked through the Hospital's monthly Infectious Control Meeting by the Infectious Control Nurse. Dr. Tack will assist in the coordination of connecting DOH with this monthly meeting. Obtaining real time data regarding heroin overdoses was also discussed. Dr. Smith stressed the importance of the hospital retrieving as much data as possible; bag or container substance was in, name of batch, etc. An update regarding the details of the July mass gathering was also provided by Dr. Smith.
- NYSDOH Prevention Agenda Dashboard: Dr. Smith demonstrated the use of the NYSDOH Prevention Agenda Dashboard to the Board as this tool will be instrumental in tracking the changing health statistics of Ulster County and assisting Ulster County DOH implementation of the Community Health Improvement Plan.
