1. Approval of Minutes: A Motion to approve the November minutes was made by Mr. McLaughlin, seconded by Dr. Wade and unanimously approved.

2. Chairperson's Report:

A. <u>Slate of Officers:</u> A motion was made by Mr. McLaughlin to accept the existing Slate of Officers for 2015. The motion was seconded by Ms. Flanagan Kelly and unanimously approved.

3. Administrative Report:

A. Mobile Crisis: A team from Occupations, Inc. gave a presentation to the Board regarding the new mobile crisis services being implemented in Ulster County. This service will be offered 70 hours per week, 7 days a week, 1:00PM - 11:00PM. The primary areas to be served are Highland, New Paltz, Ellenville, Saugerties and Kingston. Currently, in the process of interviewing and hiring staff. Looking to hire team members who are already vested in Ulster County. The intent of the Mobile Crisis service is to prevent hospitalizations through the use of on the spot interventions, ex: at home, at school, at work. Teams of two are sent out to any visit, one

LCSW/LMSW and the other may be a non-licensed staff. Police Departments may also attend a visit if there is a safety concern. Mobile Crisis staff will work closely with Behavioral Health Providers and will conduct well checks for those who do not show up for their appointments. The mobile crisis service will be used for all populations. Anyone with a behavioral health or substance abuse crisis can utilize the service. Currently, Occupations, Inc. has a psychiatrist who works with the Orange County Mobile Crisis Unit and they will be expanding their hours to assist Ulster's Mobile Crisis.

A datasheet demonstrating the activities of the Orange County Mobile Crisis Team was distributed (see attached) for the Board to review.

Services are expected to be up and running by January 1, 2015.

Mr. Crannell thanked the Board, Occupations, Inc. and UCDMH team for their work with the RFP. The County is looking forward to working with Occupations, Inc. Mr. Crannell also announced that there is additional State funding available to expand the Mobile Crisis into a County-wide service. The County Executive is committed to making this a successful service.

- B. <u>New RCPC Clinic:</u> Ms. Dagirmanjian announced that approval has been given to RCPC to launch a clinic at the Cahill Elementary School in Saugerties. IDT services will continue.
- C. <u>IFH Behavioral Health Expansion:</u> IFH has been given approval to open a crisis center at the Miller middle school in Kingston.
- D. <u>Astor Service Expansion</u>: In the process of a satellite clinic in the Ellenville School District.

- 5. New Business: Mr. McLaughlin raised some concerns that the Autism Training that Health Alliance received is not being implemented. Ms. McCracken will contact the hospitals ombudsman to inquire.

- 7. **Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned on a motion by Ms. McCracken, which was seconded by Ms. Pabon.
