Call To Order: 5:15PM

Old Business

a. Approval of Minutes: A motion to approve the minutes from the August 2022 meetings, was made by Ms. Stevens and seconded by Ms. Rogan and unanimously approved.

Commissioner's Update: Dr Smith reported on the following:

a. COVID Update:

- Reviewed the most recent COVID numbers (see attached).
- Ulster County is considered to be at a mild-moderate transmission rate. There have been few serious COVID cases reported, most fall into the mild-moderate range. However, the death numbers have been increasing.
- COVID is not behind us, people are confused and the CDC is still highly recommending that individuals get boosted.
- Schools are still required to report positive cases to their local Department of Health.

b. Other Communicable Disease Updates:

Polio Update:

- a. Rockland and Orange currently have active cases. One unvaccinated individual in Rockland County has contacted paraplegic polio. 10% of individuals who contract polio get the paraplegic polio. Governor Hochul has declared a Polio Disaster in NYS.
- b. Currently there is wastewater testing being conducted in municipal treatment plants for COVID. The CDC agreed to add polio to this testing. Both COVID and polio testing will happen at the Kingston

- and New Paltz wastewater treatment plant. The first test results are forthcoming.
- c. Local Health Departments are currently working with the State to get vaccine for those unvaccinated individuals. The State is not giving counties free vaccine. The rate is approximately \$1800 per 50 doses.
- Monkeypox Update: Dr. Smith reported that to date, 67 doses of the Jynneous vaccine have been administered. The demand has not been huge. UCDOH is giving vaccine to those individuals that feel they need it.

c. Medical Examiner Stats:

- The stats for the Medical Examiner's Office were distributed to the Board. (See Attached).
- UCDOH is asking that the two Medicolegal Investigators go from a 35-hour work week to a 40-hour work week to compensate them more for the enormous amount of hours they invest weekly.

d. Other DOH Business:

- Dr Smith reported that the Department will be receiving pandemic relief funding from the State. These monies are to promote and rebuild some of the core infrastructures DOH lost during the pandemic.
- Dr Smith was appointed to the New York State Association of Counties (NYSAC) Public Health and Mental Health Sub-Committee. She is also Past President for the New York State Association for County Health Officials (NYSACHO) Executive Committee. These organizations play a key role in creating policy, policy change and helping to craft legislation in supporting public health efforts.
- Dr Smith is also waiting for the departmental presentation to the Ulster County Legislature to be scheduled.
- Ms. Turco asked Dr. Smith if there was any anticipation for an increase in cases as individuals "return" and classes and activities resume.
 Dr. Smith stressed that COVID is not

over, and it needs to stop being talked about as though it is behind us. Individuals should continue to be safe, vaccinate and protect themselves.

6. Adjournment: Motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Rogan and seconded by Ms. Stevens and unanimously approved.






